VAXOL Ltd is a company registered and based in Scotland (collectively referred to as "we" or "us" in this policy).

OVERVIEW

Maintaining the security of your data is a priority at Vaxol, and we are committed to respecting your privacy rights. We pledge to handle your data fairly and legally at all times. Vaxol is also dedicated to being transparent about what data we collect about you and how we use it.

This policy provides you with information about:

- how we use your data;
- what personal data we collect;
- how we ensure your privacy is maintained; and
- your legal rights relating to your personal data.

What data do we collect?

We will collect certain personal information from and about you in the course of your relationship with us.

This information includes your name, address, age, gender, contact details, location information.

We may collect this information from you when you use our website, enter into competitions, make a product enquiry (via email, letter or telephone), or otherwise correspond with us.

How do we use your data?

We are processing your information:

- to be able to provide you with the information that you request from us
- for marketing purposes (where you have agreed)
- to provide you with any product / service information that we think is in your legitimate interest to receive (such as product information / dosage updates)
- to administer any competitions / special offers you have entered or signed up for

We won't use your information for any other purposes unless we are required to do so by law.

How do we ensure your privacy?

All data is stored safely and securely at Vaxol and only accessible by relevant personnel.

How long do we keep your data?

We will not retain your data for longer than necessary for the purposes set out in this Policy. Different retention periods apply for different types of data, however the longest we will normally hold any personal data is 6 years.

What are your rights?

The right to access your data – you can contact us at any time to access your information and request any necessary changes

The right to be forgotten – you can ask us at any time to delete the data we hold

The right to object – you can object at any point to the way we are handling your data

We will endeavour to respond to all requests within one month of receiving them.

Cookies

Our websites use cookies to collect information. This includes information about browsing by people who access our websites; information about pages viewed, and the customer journey around our websites.

What are cookies?

Like most websites, Vaxol websites use cookies to collect information. Cookies are small data files which are placed on your computer or other devices (such as smart 'phones or 'tablets') as you browse this website. They are used to 'remember' when your computer or device accesses our websites. Cookies are essential for the effective operation of our website. They are used enhance our services offered to you, both on our website and elsewhere.

Information collected

Some cookies collect information about browsing behaviour when you access this website via the same computer or device. This includes information about pages viewed and your journey around our website. We do not use cookies to collect or record information on your name, address or other contact details. Vaxol can use cookies to monitor your browsing behaviour.

What are cookies used for?

The main purposes for which cookies are used are: –

- 1. For technical purposes essential to effective operation of our websites, particularly in relation to on-line transactions and site navigation.
- 2. For Vaxol to market to you, particularly web banner advertisements and targeted updates.
- 3. To enable Vaxol to collect information about your browsing or patterns, including to monitor the success of campaigns, competitions etc.

How do I disable cookies?

If you want to disable cookies you need to change your website browser settings to reject cookies. How you can do this will depend on the browser you use. Further details on how to disable cookies for the most popular browsers are set out below: –

For Microsoft Internet Explorer:

- 1. Choose the menu "tools" then "Internet Options"
- 2. Click on the "privacy" tab
- 3. Select the setting the appropriate setting

For Google Chrome:

- 1. Choose Settings> Advanced
- 2. Under "Privacy and security," click "Content settings".
- 3. Click "Cookies"

For Safari:

- 1. Choose Preferences > Privacy
- 2. Click on "Remove all Website Data"

For Mozilla firefox:

- 1. Choose the menu "tools" then "Options"
- 2. Click on the icon "privacy"
- 3. Find the menu "cookie" and select the relevant options

For Opera 6.0 and further:

- 1. Choose the menu Files"> "Preferences"
- 2. Privacy

What happens if I disable cookies?

This depends on which cookies you disable, but in general the website may not operate properly if cookies are switched off. If you only disable third party cookies, you will not be unable to use out website. If you disable all cookies, this may limit your ability to use all features on our site.

Google Analytics

When someone visits vaxol.hu we use a third-party service, Google Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way which does not identify anyone. We do not make, and do not allow Google to make, any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website.
